## WHAT IS A PERSONAL MISSION ACTIVITY?

The Missions Board of Redeemer Lutheran Church encourages all Redeemer members to serve as witnesses for Christ through personal mission activities.

These are broadly defined as activities undertaken by a member or group of members of Redeemer to share their faith and love for Christ **and** to serve the needs of others.

## WHO SHOULD BE INVOLVED?

**Everyone.** Do not think this is only the Church's job, or someone else's responsibility, or that you are not capable.

## WHY IS PERSONAL MINISTRY IMPORTANT?

As members of Redeemer **We Worship, We Witness, and We Serve** so others can **Belong** to the Kingdom of God.

Jesus commanded each one of us as a believer in Christ to witness and share our faith.

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations . . . ."

Matthew 28:19

Jesus also called each one of us to serve our neighbor:

"For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me. . . . I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me."

## WHAT ARE EXAMPLES OF PERSONAL MISSION ACTIVITIES?

Some Personal Mission Activities are simple and do not require any outside funding.

Preparing a meal for a friend or neighbor and telling them about Jesus.

Volunteering at a community organization that is sharing Christ's message and love.

Inviting a new acquaintance to Redeemer and offering to drive them in your car.

Patiently listening to a person who is hurting and then asking if you can pray for him or her.

Other Personal Mission Activities may require some funding.

Supplies for a service activity that also involves sharing a message about Christ.

Welcome baskets and invitations to hear more about the love of Christ for people who move into the neighborhood or community.

Care packages that include Christian materials, e.g., a paperback copy of the New Testament.

Meals for groups of people followed by a Bible study.
