Going on a mission trip is always an adventure, but never more so than when you are trying to keep up with Pastor Mark Eisold, who is filled with energy and passion to reach people outside of the church who are not in a relationship with Jesus yet. He is one of Redeemer's longest standing mission partnerships that has taken many surprising turns over the years from the country of Peru to ministry at the Pelican church in Naples, FL:

October 2010 Pastor Mark visits Redeemer for the first time. January 2011 Pastor Mark moves to Lima to establish a Lutheran church body in Peru. June 2013 Redeemer sends a mission eyeglass team to Lima, Peru. January 2016 The Eisold family returns to the US & settles in Naples, Florida. December 2016 Pastor Mark is called to reach out to Hispanic immigrants. September 2017 Hurricane Irma hits Florida & Redeemer reconnects with Pastor Mark. December 2018 Redeemer sends high school youth over Christmas break to teach English at the Pelican. Other youth teams follow in December 2019, July 2021, and July 2023. February 2020 Pastor Mark begins mentoring men to become deacons. March 2020 Covid pandemic hits & church outreach takes many new forms to teach, baptize, confirm, and mentor members. May 2022 The Pelican thrives and grows and becomes a chartered congregation of the LCMS. September 2023 Pastor Mark and the Pelican adopt the defunct Amigos ministries of Southwest Florida.

**February 2024** Pastor Mark begins training 11 women as deaconesses.

**July 2024** Pastor Aaron plans to lead the fifth trip of 15 high school youth and four adults for another exciting ESL camp.

Whatever the future, we know the Lord has a plan. Hopefully God He invites us to join Him! Come and celebrate with us these 14+ years of this wonderful mission partnership and catch a vision for the future! Stay tuned to the midweek newsletter for further details to RSVP for April 15th.
